Exactly 200 days after closing to the public due to COVID-19, Superior Public Library reopens – no appointment needed – on Monday, October 5. You can visit the library Monday through Thursday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., with extended hours on Tuesdays until 7 p.m. We will allow a limited number of patrons in the building at one time and will offer a limited number of computers for public use

first-come, first-served. Patrons must wear masks while they are in the building and are asked to limit their time in the library to one hour. Please observe social distancing while in the library and continue to use the outdoor book drop for returning all library materials. If you're experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, please do not come to the library.



For those who prefer a contactless way to obtain library materials, we'll still be offering curbside pickup on Fridays and Saturdays! Call the library to place your requests and schedule your pickup time. Appointments will be available from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Fridays and 10 a.m. to 2 p.m on

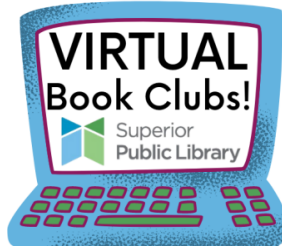
Storytime in the Park
